

### **ACOTE D STANDARDS**

### D.1.1. Collaboration for Designing the Doctoral

### **Capstone** (2018 standard D.1.2. & D.1.6)

Ensure that the doctoral capstone is designed through collaboration with the student, a faculty member in the occupational therapy educational program who holds a doctoral degree, and an individual with documented expertise in the content area of the capstone.



## D.1.2. Content Expert for Doctoral Capstone

**Document** that the **content expert is informed** of the plan for and purpose of the doctoral capstone and **has content expertise in the focus area**.



### D.1.3. Design and Preparation of Doctoral Capstone

(2018 Standard D.1.1., 1.2., & 1.3.)

**<u>Document</u>** that the doctoral capstone is an integral part of the program's curriculum design and:

- Reflects the mission and philosophy of the program.
- Contributes to the development of **in-depth knowledge** in the designated area of interest.
- Includes preparation consisting of a <u>literature review</u>, <u>needs</u> assessment, <u>goals/objectives</u>, and a <u>plan to evaluate</u> project outcomes.

This must be completed **prior** to the commencement of the 14-week doctoral capstone experience. **The doctoral capstone must be started after completion of all coursework and Level II fieldwork** 

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## D.1.3. Additional Clarification

- Literature Review/ Needs Assessment
  - Program to determine the scope of these tasks in relation to the capstone
  - Specific to the design and capstone preparation
- Refer to the glossary
  - CAPSTONE PROJECT: An individual project that is completed by a doctoral-level student that demonstrates the student's ability to relate theory to practice and to synthesize in-depth knowledge in a practice area that relates to the capstone experience.

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# D.1.4. Experiential Plan and Written Agreement for Doctoral Capstone

<u>Document</u> that the process for ensuring <u>valid written agreements</u> between the organization and the program are in effect <u>prior to and for the duration</u> of the capstone experience.

Ensure that there is a valid <u>plan</u> for the individual doctoral capstone experience that, at a minimum, includes:

- Individualized specific doctoral capstone experience objectives
- Plans for evaluation, supervision, and mentoring
- Responsibilities of all parties

The agreement must be signed by all parties.



## D.1.5. Length of Doctoral Capstone Experience

Require that the length of the doctoral capstone experience be a **minimum of 14 weeks' full-time**, and a **minimum of 32 hours per week**. This may be completed on a part-time basis as agreed upon by the organization and must be consistent with the individualized specific objectives and capstone project. This must be equivalent in length to 14 full-time of at least 32 hours per week.

The program must have a <u>mechanism to document</u> that the students meet the requirements for capstone length. Prior fieldwork or work experience may not be substituted for this doctoral capstone experience.

### D.1.5. Additional Clarification

- Need to align experience with objectives of the project and plan.
- Context/physical location highly dependent upon type and objective of project.
- Minimum requirement and allows flexibility; depend on policies to minimum hours and how hours can be made up.



## D.1.6. Doctoral Capstone Project

(2018 Standard D.1.8.)

Ensure completion and dissemination of an individual doctoral capstone project that relates to the doctoral capstone experience and demonstrates synthesis of in-depth knowledge in the focused area of study.

# D.1.7. Evaluation of Doctoral Capstone

<u>Document a formal evaluation</u> mechanism for objective assessment of the student's performance <u>during and at the completion</u> of the doctoral capstone.
