Criteria 11: Relevance to Occupational Therapy

- Content is relevant to the profession of occupational therapy - Content falls within
- the scope of practice of occupational therapy
- Content is consistent with AOTA official documents (e.g., Occupational Therapy Framework)

Occupational Therapy Categories

- OT Service Delivery
- Professional Issues
- Foundational Knowledge



Criteria 12: Evidence

Where applicable, content included in PD activities is evidence-informed and reflects best practice. All PD activities must be supported by the most current literature.

Evidence may include:

- Peer reviewed journal articles
- Resources (e.g., CATs, CAPs, CPGs, AOTA Tip Sheets)
- Textbooks (e.g., theory)
