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<p><b>Criteria 11: Relevance to Occupational Therapy</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Content is relevant to the profession of occupational therapy</li> <li>- Content falls within the scope of practice of occupational therapy</li> <li>- Content is consistent with AOTA official documents (e.g., Occupational Therapy Framework)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Occupational Therapy Categories</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- OT Service Delivery</li> <li>- Professional Issues</li> <li>- Foundational Knowledge</li> </ul>
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<p><b>Criteria 12: Evidence</b></p>	<p>Where applicable, content included in PD activities is evidence-informed and reflects best practice. <b>All</b> PD activities must be supported by the most current literature.</p>	<p><b>Evidence may include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Peer reviewed journal articles</li> <li>- Resources (e.g., CATs, CAPs, CPGs, AOTA Tip Sheets)</li> <li>- Textbooks (e.g., theory)</li> </ul>
